2011 THE JAWN Syrah

Tasting Notes

The 2011 Syrah has aromas of orange peel and raspberry with undertones of bay leaf and white pepper. The chalky tannins and acid backbone play wonderfully off each other to give this balanced Syrah a long and pleasant finish.

Vineyard

Vivio Vineyard, planted 2001

Appellation: Bennett Valley

Clones: 470, 877

Vineyard Site: gravelly clay loam at 900

Winemaking

Harvest Brix: 23.5

Alcohol: 14.2% ABV

Yeast: Native ferment

Malic Acid: native

Ferment: 70% whole cluster, fermented in small stainless steel tanks, hand punched and left on skins for 24 days. Aged in 40% new French oak for 18 months. Bottled unfinned and unfiltered.

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
